

**PENGGUNA LEBUHRAYA PLUS DINASIHAT RANCANG
PERJALANAN LEBIH AWAL SUSULAN PENUTUPAN LALUAN
SEMPENA SIDANG KEMUNCIAK ASEAN 2025**

Petaling Jaya, 22 Mei 2025:- PLUS Malaysia Berhad (PLUS) merujuk kepada kenyataan media yang dikeluarkan oleh Jabatan Siasatan dan Penguatkuasaan Trafik (JSPT), Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) baru-baru ini berhubung penutupan beberapa laluan sempena penganjuran Sidang Kemuncak ASEAN 2025.

Antara laluan yang terlibat dengan penutupan secara berperingkat termasuklah beberapa jajaran di lebuhraya kendalian PLUS adalah seperti berikut:-

Sehubungan itu, pihak PLUS akan bersiap sedia dan mengambil langkah-langkah sewajarnya bagi memastikan kelancaran operasi di lebuhraya kendalian PLUS sepanjang tempoh tersebut. Dalam masa yang sama, pihak PLUS akan memberikan kerjasama sepenuhnya kepada pihak berkuasa, khususnya anggota trafik yang bertugas bagi memudahkan pergerakan delegasi di lokasi-lokasi yang melalui Lebuhraya PLUS.

Justeru, PLUS menasihatkan pengguna lebuhraya terutamanya yang menuju ke atau dari Lapangan Terbang Antarabangsa Kuala Lumpur (KLIA) dan TUDM Subang, supaya merancang perjalanan lebih awal bagi mengelakkan sebarang kelewatan.

Orang ramai juga disaran supaya memberikan kerjasama sepenuhnya dan mematuhi arahan pihak berkuasa dan petugas trafik di lokasi. Jika pemanduan tidak dapat dielakkan, sila gunakan laluan alternatif bagi mengelakkan kesesakan lalu lintas ketika penutupan laluan dilaksanakan.

Untuk makluman trafik terkini, pengguna lebuh raya boleh merujuk kemas kini melalui platform media sosial JSPT/PDRM, aplikasi PLUS, X @PLUSTrafik, atau papan tanda elektronik (VMS) di lokasi-lokasi terpilih di lebuh raya. Pengguna juga digalakkan untuk menggunakan aplikasi navigasi seperti *Google Maps* dan *Waze* bagi merancang perjalanan dengan lebih efisien.

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**PLUS HIGHWAY USERS ARE ADVISED TO PLAN AHEAD
DUE TO ROAD CLOSURES IN CONJUNCTION WITH
ASEAN SUMMIT 2025**

Petaling Jaya, 22 May 2025: PLUS Malaysia Berhad (PLUS) refers to the media statement issued by the Traffic Investigation and Enforcement (JSPT), Royal Malaysia Police (PDRM) regarding several road closures in conjunction with the ASEAN Summit 2025, recently.

Among the roads affected by the staggered road closures includes several stretches along PLUS-operated highways are listed as follows:-

In accordance, PLUS will remain ready to take all necessary measures to ensure smooth traffic flow along its highways throughout the period. At the same time, PLUS will give full cooperation to the authorities, particularly the traffic officers in duty to facilitate the movement of delegations along stretches passing through PLUS' highways.

Therefore, PLUS advises highway users, especially those travelling to or from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) and TUDM Subang to plan ahead to avoid any delays.

The public is also advised to give full cooperation and to adhere instructions given by the authorities and traffic personnels on the effected locations. If driving is unavoidable, please use alternative routes to avoid traffic congestion during the road closures.

For the latest traffic information, highway users may refer to updates via JSPT/PDRM social media platforms, the PLUS app, X @PLUSTrafik, or Variable Message Signs (VMS) at selected highway locations. Users are also encouraged to use navigation apps such as Google Maps and Waze to plan their journeys efficiently.

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
