

TRAFFIC DISPERSAL PROJECT BETWEEN JURU AND SUNGAI DUA TOLL PLAZAS ON THE NORTH-SOUTH EXPRESSWAY (PLUS) AND SURROUNDING AREAS TO COMMENCE ON 21 OCTOBER 2025

Petaling Jaya, 21 October 2025:- PLUS Malaysia Berhad (PLUS) today announced that Package 1 of the Traffic Dispersal Project between Juru and Sungai Dua Toll Plazas (PTJSD) will commence today, 21 October 2025.

NAZA Engineering & Construction Sdn Bhd has been appointed as the main contractor for this package following an open tender process. Package 1, which involves upgrading the roundabout at the East-West Interchange (KM135.15 – KM135.4) and the construction of a new bridge on Jalan Tun Hussein Onn (KM133.5 – KM134.5), will be carried out over a period of 24 months.

Package 1 is part of the overall PTJSD project packages. It aims to improve traffic flow in the area and will help highway users as well as local residents enjoy smoother travel in the future.

Overall, the PTJSD Project is a high-impact initiative and will benefit approximately 200,000 daily users by reducing congestion along the affected stretch.

At the initial stage, preliminary works will not disrupt traffic flow as the two existing lanes in both directions of the highway will remain open to users.

PLUS will also provide updates on the project's progress from time to time through its social media channels.
