

## **PLUS ADVISES MOTORISTS TO PLAN THEIR JOURNEYS AHEAD IN CONJUNCTION WITH SCHOOL HOLIDAYS AND LONG FESTIVE BREAK - PLUS ready to manage anticipated traffic surge**

**Petaling Jaya, 20 May 2026:-** PLUS Malaysia Berhad (PLUS) advises highway users to plan their balik kampung journeys or holidays ahead as traffic volume is expected to increase across its highway network, including the Lebuhraya Pantai Timur 2 (LPT2), from 22 May until 7 June 2026. The anticipated increase is due to the overlapping festive and public holiday period in conjunction with Hari Raya Aidiladha, Wesak Day, the Official Birthday of His Majesty the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, as well as the Mid-Year School Holidays.

During this festive period, PLUS anticipates traffic volume across its highway network to increase up to 2.2 million vehicles daily, while LPT2 is expected to record an increase of up to 50,000 vehicles daily. Peak days for outbound travel from the Klang Valley are expected on 22, 23, 26, 28, 29, 30 and 31 May 2026, while peak days is also anticipated during return travel to the Klang Valley on 4, 5, 6 and 7 June 2026.

PLUS is fully prepared to ensure the safety and comfort of highway users remain at the highest level throughout the festive period. Through efficient traffic and incident management, PLUS will activate Smart Lanes at 33 strategic locations to increase lane capacity, deploy more than 500 PLUS Ronda and LPT2 Ronda personnel for 24-hour patrol duties, optimise toll plaza operations by opening all toll lanes, as well as conduct round-the-clock real-time traffic monitoring via the Traffic Monitoring Centre (TMC).

To assist motorists in planning their journeys more efficiently on the PLUS highways and LPT2, PLUS encourages the public to refer to the MyPLUS-TTA digital travel schedule via the PLUS app. Highway users are advised to follow the suggested MyPLUS-TTA travel schedule to help ensure smoother journeys and reduce traffic congestion. In addition, the public may obtain further information and access the digital MyPLUS-TTA travel schedule, as well as download or update the PLUS app to facilitate smoother and more efficient journey planning.

In addition, through strategic collaboration with the Royal Malaysia Police (PDRM), the Road Transport Department (JPJ), the Malaysian Highway Authority (LLM) and related agencies, PLUS remains committed to facilitate smoother traffic flow and ensure highway safety remains at an optimum level throughout the festive season.

Highway users may obtain the latest traffic updates through the PLUS app, PUTRI Virtual Assistant, @plustrafik and @lpt2trafik on X, Variable Message Signboards (VMS) at selected locations, as well as through major radio stations nationwide.

Motorists may also contact the PLUSLine at 1800-88-0000 and the LPT2Line at 1800-88-0220 should they require assistance on the highway. Highway users are advised to utilise the PLUS app to plan their journey or use navigation apps such as Waze or Google Maps while on the move throughout the festive period.

In the meantime, PLUS reminds highway users to ensure that their Touch 'n Go card balance or eWallet (for RFID and JustGO users) is sufficient before beginning their journey on the highway.

Motorists are also reminded to ensure that their vehicles are in good condition before beginning their journeys, remain cautious when driving in rainy weather, have sufficient rest, drive responsibly and adhere with traffic regulations for the safety of all road users.
