

## **PROJEK PENYURAIAN TRAFIK JURU-SUNGAI DUA SEDANG BERJALAN DENGAN RANCAK**

**Petaling Jaya, 7 Mei 2026:-** Projek Penyuraian Trafik Juru–Sungai Dua (PTJSD) terus menunjukkan kemajuan apabila kerja-kerja awalan bagi Pakej 1 telah disiapkan, manakala kerja-kerja pengalihan utiliti, geoteknikal dan lain-lain sedang giat dijalankan di tapak projek.

Pakej 1, yang merupakan salah satu pakej bagi pelaksanaan PTJSD, meliputi kerja-kerja menaiktaraf bulatan di Persimpangan Bertingkat Timur–Barat (KM135.15 – KM135.4) serta pembinaan jambat baharu di Jalan Tun Hussein Onn (KM133.5 – KM134.5).

Sehingga pertengahan April 2026, kerja-kerja awalan projek yang telah dilaksanakan merangkumi beberapa aktiviti teknikal seperti Ukur Topografi (Topography Survey), Pemetaan Pengesanan Utiliti (Utilities Detection Mapping - UDM), Penyiasatan Tanah (Soil Investigation - SI), Kajian Keadaan Struktur Sedia Ada (Dilapidation Survey) serta Kerja Perintisan (Piloting). Pencapaian ini mencerminkan komitmen semua pihak yang terlibat dalam memastikan asas pelaksanaan projek berada pada landasan yang kukuh.

Pada masa yang sama, kerja-kerja pengalihan utiliti sedang giat dilaksanakan dan kini telah mencapai kira-kira 55% kemajuan, hasil koordinasi yang baik di antara LLM dan PLUS bersama beberapa agensi utiliti utama termasuk Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB), Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang (PBAPP) dan TIME dotCom Berhad.

Seiring dengan itu, kerja-kerja geoteknikal sedang dilaksanakan di lokasi projek, antaranya melibatkan pemasangan Saliran Menegak Prafabrikasi (Prefabricated Vertical Drain - PVD) dan Surcaj, pemasangan Tambak Cerucuk (Pile Embankment), Cerucuk Ujian Awal (Preliminary Test Pile - PTP) dan penyediaan Pelan Pengurusan Trafik (TMP), serta kerja-kerja pemecahan saliran sedia ada bagi memudahkan pelaksanaan kerja pembinaan seterusnya.

PTJSD merupakan projek berimpak tinggi yang dilaksanakan bagi menyediakan infrastruktur yang mampan dan memberi manfaat kepada rakyat. Ia bertujuan untuk mengurangkan kesesakan di koridor Juru–Sungai Dua, yang merupakan antara laluan paling sibuk di Lebuhraya Utara–Selatan. Apabila siap kelak, projek ini dijangka akan meningkatkan kelancaran aliran trafik, memendekkan masa perjalanan pengguna lebuhraya serta menyokong pembangunan ekonomi yang berterusan di Pulau Pinang dan kawasan utara Semenanjung Malaysia.

## **JURU–SUNGAI DUA TRAFFIC DISPERSAL PROJECT PROGRESSING RAPIDLY**

**Petaling Jaya, 7 May 2026:-** The Juru–Sungai Dua Traffic Dispersal Project (PTJSD) continues to progress, with preliminary works for Package 1 now completed, while utility relocation, geotechnical works and other related activities are actively underway at the project site.

Package 1, one of the key components of PTJSD, involves the upgrading of the roundabout at the East–West Interchange (KM135.15 – KM135.4), as well as the construction of a new flyover at Jalan Tun Hussein Onn (KM133.5 – KM134.5).

As of mid-April 2026, preliminary works were successfully carried out such as Topographical Survey, Utilities Detection Mapping (UDM), Soil Investigation (SI), Dilapidation Survey and Piloting Works. These achievements reflect the strong commitment of all parties involved in ensuring a solid foundation for the project.

At the same time, utility relocation works are being actively carried out and have reached approximately 55% progress. The progress is the result of effective coordination between MHA and PLUS together with the key utility agencies including Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB), Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang (PBAPP) and TIME dotCom Berhad.

Concurrently, geotechnical works are currently underway at the project site, including the installation of Prefabricated Vertical Drains (PVD) and surcharge, pile embankments, Preliminary Test Piles (PTP), preparation of the Traffic Management Plan (TMP), as well as diversion of existing drainage systems to facilitate subsequent construction works.

PTJSD is a high-impact project implemented to deliver sustainable infrastructure and generate meaningful benefits for the public. It aims to alleviate congestion along the Juru–Sungai Dua corridor, one of the busiest stretches on the North–South Expressway. Upon completion, the project is expected to improve traffic flow, reduce travel time for highway users and support continuous economic growth in Penang and the northern region of Peninsular Malaysia.
